



Tree & Plant Health Care Program

First Seasonal Visit

Early Spring – 1st Fertilizer If Planted After June & 1st Insecticide
Imidacloprid & Mineral Oil As Preventative Action

Second Seasonal Visit

Spring / Early Summer – Plant Diagnosis & 2nd Insecticide
Bifenthrin & Mineral Oil

Third Seasonal Visit

Summer – 3rd Insecticide
Imidacloprid, Bifenthrin, Cyfluthrin

Fourth Seasonal Visit

Late Summer / Fall – 4th Insecticide (If Necessary)
1st Fall Fertilizer
Colonise LTO & Bio 12-6-6

Fifth Seasonal Visit

Fall – 2nd Fall Fertilizer
Chloroburst

Deep Root Injections Only Done On Client Request Recommended Time Is Spring/Fall
Examples of Common Insect & The Plants They Affect During the Year (Weather Dependent)

Insect	Example Plant	Month Affected
Tent Caterpillars	Crabapple Tree	April – October
Scale	Holly Bush	June – August
Aphids	Crape Myrtle	April – October
Spider Mites	Alberta Spruce	June – August
Bagworms	Arborvitae	May – August
Japanese Beetles	Roses / Cherry Tree	June – August
Fall Webworms	Oak / Maple Tree	August – November

Additional Specialty Visits

April – Mosquito Control (Multiple Visits Can Be Added)
Spring-Fall – Flea & Tick Control (Multiple Visits)
Spring-Fall – Fungicide (No Preventative Available Only Post)
May/June – Preventative Grub Control
June/July – Water Management Control
Year Round – Termite Preventative (Multiple Visits Are Required No Guarantee)
